

ISO 639-3 Change Requests Series 2009

Summary of Outcomes

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Summary of requested changes

There were 89 requests considered, recommending 137 explicit changes in the code set. Twelve of the requests are still pending. Of the 77 requests that have been decided, eight have been rejected, five have been partially adopted, and 64 have been fully approved. The eleven requests still pending will be reported in an addendum to this report.

The 85 explicit changes can be analyzed as follows:

- Retirements: 18
 - 8 merged languages;
 - 9 split languages, resulting in 20 new language code elements (net gain of 11);
 - 1 retirement of code element representing a language sub-family whose constituents were already present in code set.
- Completely new languages: 14 newly created languages not previously associated with another language in the code set: 12 living languages and 2 extinct languages. (Two of these were proposed as splits, but a code element split was deemed unnecessary.)
- New languages added with the change of scope of a code element from individual to macrolanguage: 5
- Updates: 47
 - 37 name updates, either change to a name form or addition of a name form;
 - 7 denotation updates of languages into which other varieties were merged;
 - 1 macrolanguage group update;
 - 2 new macrolanguage groups (existing individual language changed in scope to macrolanguage);
